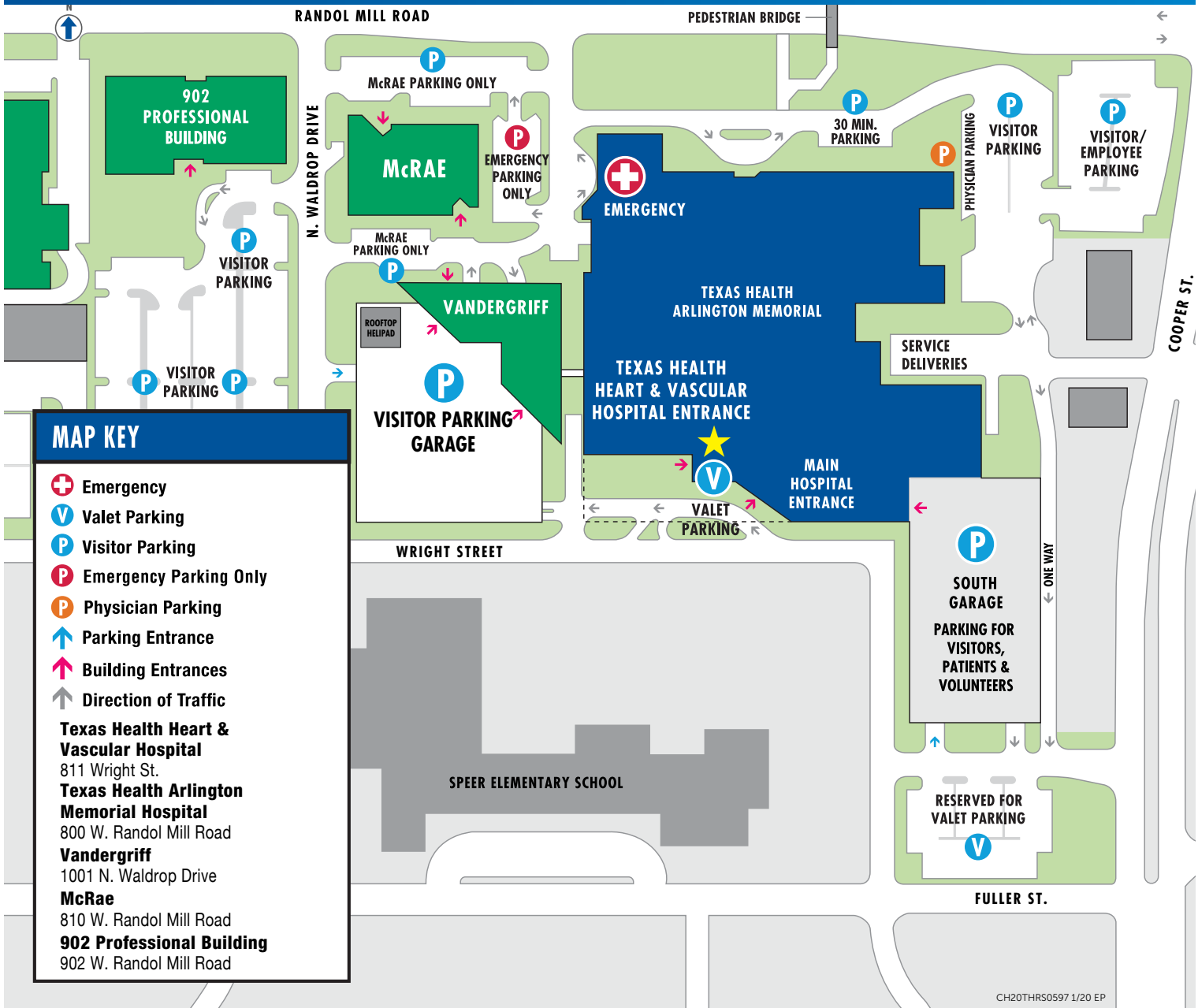


The Bistro Café and Coffee Bar are closed on weekends and holidays.
